17-24 July 2010 (10 - 5) - Rainbow Journeys
with Dr. Sue Jennings, Sharon Jacksties and visiting Tutors
6 day Summer School in Romania

We will explore *A Midsummer Night's Dream* through text, metaphors and stories, and the role of the trickster. Arrive two days early and work with Sue Jennings with children on the autistic spectrum from 'Crystal Children'. **8 days in total: £600 (including tuition, group work, supervision, and light refreshments, notes and folders). £550 if paid in full by 1 June.**

21 August 2010 (10 - 5) - Introduction to Play Therapy
with Dr. Sue Jennings and Alison Chown
Why is play essential to healthy development?

Many people forget how important playing is in their lives; it's a means of exploring, learning and struggling with life issues. We shall use toys, puppets and stories to rediscover the importance of play for health and healing. We shall learn through fun! **Students: £60 one day, £110 both days Non-Students: £75 one day, £120 both days 10% reduction if paid in full by 15 June.**

22 August 2010 (10 - 5) - Introduction to Dramatherapy
with Dr. Sue Jennings

'Action Learning' is an essential tool for special education, addiction and mental health issues.

This practical one day course provides skills and knowledge about what it means to be a Dramatherapist. Participants will experience Dramatherapy techniques, including movement, stories and games, as well as hearing case histories. It promises to be a lively day with lots of fun and learning! **Fees same as on 21 August.**

27 – 30 August 2010 (10 - 5) - Creative Supervision (iii)
with Dr. Sue Jennings, Linda Winn, Jude Kidd

Live supervision practice, individual supervision, supervision 'in the group' and 'supervision through the group', ethics and responsibilities. **Full course £340 / £300 if paid by 15 June.**

23 October 2010 (10 - 5) - Introduction to Creative Supervision
with Jude Kidd

An introduction to the skills and processes necessary for supervision. We will make use of creative media such as sand tray and puppets to understand in greater depth the dynamic between therapist and client and therapist and supervisor. **Students £75 Non-Students £95 (Including light refreshments and notes).**
