1. PLAY THERAPY AND DRAMATHERAPY, 4 - 6 April 2008, Brasov

RESILIENCE, ATTACHMENT AND TRAUMA (Friday 1800-2200, Saturday 1000-1700, Sunday 1000-1400)

A practical course for people working with troubled teenagers and children. It includes the latest theory and practice, with take-away techniques relevant to your work setting. There will be time for work-related questions.

2. CREATIVE SUMMER SCHOOL 2008, 1- 5 August, Zarnesti

FAIRY TALES AND THE SHADOW

This 5 day training course is on therapeutic storytelling and its application in therapy and personal growth. We shall focus on Romanian and Asian tales to explore the 'dark lands' that are perhaps too scary to confront in everyday life. We will use play, movement, painting, clay, music, masks and drama and work in nature as well as in our beautiful studio overlooking the Carpathian forests and mountains. The course includes practical workshops, presentations as well as a picnic. Romanian participants have the opportunity to mingle with practitioners from other countries and develop their networking and skills.

Fees

For the five day course, lunches and snacks and social programme, teaching folder: 300 ron. Places can be reserved with a 50 ron deposit (non returnable). Certificates of attendance and formal stamped receipts will be issued at the end of the course. (This course consists of 30 hours of credit towards the play and dramatherapy certification). Two bursaries are available.

4. WORKING CREATIVELY WITH AUTISM 15-16 November Zarnesti

Saturday 1000-1900, Sunday 1000 - 1500

This two day practical workshop is for parents, teachers and clinicians. We shall explore new approaches for children and adults with autism and other learning difficulties. Dr Sue Jennings has worked extensively with people with autism in the UK and Germany and more recently in Malaysia where she is assisting the Malaysian Autistic Society to establish a specialised teacher-training programme. The methods will include creative ways of transforming repetitive behaviours such as rocking and head banging. There will be presentations and a DVD of direct work.

Fee: including notes and lunch: 80 ron.

All participants receive a certificate of attendance and formal stamped receipt. (This course is 15 hours leading towards certification in play and dramatherapy).
